VOLTAshow03 — Basel's discriminating fair for cutting-edge art — releases exhibitor list and announces new section inspired by this year's *Muenster Skulptur Projekte: the Outdoor | Sculpture Project*. Large-scale sculptural interventions will animate the industrial location of the ULTRA BRAG Hall facility in the Basel harbor.

The third edition of **VOLTAshow** in 2007 runs from Monday, June 11 through Saturday 16, once again providing a focused platform for galleries working with cutting-edge art. As well as booth presentations—many of which will offer special projects, solo presentations or revolving curated shows—**VOLTAshow03** Executive Director **Amanda Coulson** and Managing Director **Karoline Willems** announce a new section dedicated to sculpture: the **Outdoor | Sculpture Project** which will allow specially selected galleries to highlight large-scale work, otherwise difficult to exhibit in the fair context, while the riverside **Outdoor | Sculpture Project Dealer's Lounge** will offer the visitors a relaxing location to meet with the representing dealers and consult an archive/library with information on the exhibited artists. Together with the unique collaborative section of the **VOLTAshow | Zoo Art Fair Invitational**—which will focus on Nordic countries—**VOLTAshow03** offer a vista onto the global contemporary scene.
